



EVENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

Important: By purchasing, possessing, or using a ticket for a Discovery Fire event, the ticket purchaser and each attendee agree to these Terms & Conditions.

1. AGREEMENT TO TERMS

1.1 Acceptance

By purchasing, possessing, or using a ticket for any Discovery Fire event (the “Event”), you (“Guest”) agree to these Terms & Conditions.

1.2 Condition of Entry

If you do not agree to these Terms & Conditions, you must not complete your purchase or attend the Event.

2. TICKETS & PURCHASE TERMS

2.1 Final Sale

All ticket sales are final. Tickets are non-refundable and non-exchangeable except as expressly stated in these Terms & Conditions.

2.2 Experience-Based Purchase

Tickets grant access to a live, outdoor, experience-based event. Specific menu items, activities, service timing, and event elements are not guaranteed and may vary.

2.3 Authorized Purchase

Tickets must be obtained through authorized sources only.

2.4 Invalid Tickets

Tickets that are duplicated, altered, resold without authorization, or fraudulently obtained are void.

2.5 Denial of Entry

Venue reserves the right to deny entry without refund for invalid or unauthorized tickets.

3. PRICING & INCLUSIONS

3.1 Exclusions

Ticket price does not include taxes, service or processing fees, alcoholic beverages, specialty items or upgrades, or merchandise unless explicitly stated.

3.2 Additional Purchases

All items not expressly included are available, if offered, at additional cost.

4. ADMISSION, ENTRY & SECURITY

4.1 Admission Rights

Entry is limited to valid ticket holders.

4.2 Venue Discretion

Discovery Fire reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to require valid identification, inspect bags and personal items, deny entry to any individual, or remove any Guest without refund.

4.3 Re-Entry

Re-entry is not permitted unless expressly authorized by Venue.

4.4 Compliance Requirement

Failure to comply with Venue policies may result in removal without refund.

4.5 Refusal of Service

Venue reserves the right to refuse service to any Guest for safety, compliance, or operational reasons.

5. EVENT FORMAT & CONDITIONS

5.1 Rain or Shine

All Events operate rain or shine.

5.2 Outdoor Environment

Events are primarily outdoor and subject to environmental conditions.

5.3 Schedule Variability

Event timing, food service windows, layout, and programming may change without notice.

5.4 Operational Modifications

Venue may modify, delay, substitute, or eliminate event elements at its discretion.

5.5 No Refund for Changes

Such changes do not qualify for refunds.

5.6 Departure Requirement

Guests must vacate the premises promptly upon event conclusion.

6. FOOD, ALLERGENS & DIETARY RISK

6.1 Not an Allergen-Free Facility

Discovery Fire is not an allergen-free facility.

6.2 Allergen Exposure

The kitchen and service environment regularly handle common allergens, including milk, eggs, wheat/gluten, soy, peanuts, tree nuts (including coconut), sesame, fish, and shellfish.

6.3 Cross-Contact Risk

Cross-contact may occur at any stage of receiving, storage, preparation, cooking, transport, plating, or service.

6.4 No Guarantee

Venue does not guarantee that any food or beverage is free from allergens.

6.5 Severe Allergy Warning

Individuals with celiac disease, anaphylaxis, or severe allergies are advised not to consume Venue food or beverages.

6.6 Assumption of Risk

Guest assumes all risks associated with food consumption.

6.7 Purchaser Responsibility

Purchaser is responsible for communicating this allergen disclosure to all guests in their party.

6.8 Food Availability

Food and beverage offerings are subject to availability. Certain items may become unavailable during the Event due to demand or consumption patterns. This does not constitute grounds for refund.

6.9 Consumption Limitation (No Takeaway)

Food and beverages are provided strictly for on-site consumption during the Event and remain the property of Venue until consumed. Removal, packaging, or taking food or beverage items off-site is not permitted unless expressly authorized by Venue. Venue reserves the right to restrict, control, or discard any food or beverage items at its sole discretion.

7. ALCOHOL POLICY

7.1 Licensed Service

Venue is licensed to serve beer and wine only.

7.2 Prohibited Items

No outside alcohol is permitted, and no distilled spirits are allowed on site.

7.3 Service Control

Venue may refuse alcohol service at its discretion.

7.4 Removal for Alcohol Violations

Guests who are intoxicated, underage, or disruptive may be removed without refund.

8. CHILDREN & MINORS

8.1 Supervision Requirement

Children must be supervised at all times.

8.2 Alcohol Restrictions

Minors are prohibited from consuming alcohol.

8.3 Restricted Areas

Minors may not enter designated restricted areas.

9. ANIMALS

9.1 General Rule

No animals are permitted on the premises.

9.2 Service Animals

Service animals are permitted in accordance with applicable law.

10. GUEST CONDUCT

10.1 Standard of Conduct

Guests must behave in a respectful and safe manner.

10.2 Prohibited Conduct

Prohibited conduct includes, but is not limited to:

1. Aggressive or disruptive behavior
2. Underage drinking
3. Outside alcohol
4. Weapons, fireworks, or open flames
5. Backpacks, coolers, or outside food and beverages
6. Unauthorized access to restricted areas, including barns, sheds, kitchens, private structures, ponds, or creek areas
7. Smoking outside designated areas
8. Property damage or illegal activity
9. Public urination or misuse of facilities

10.3 Enforcement

Violation may result in removal without refund.

10.4 Safety Compliance

Guests must exercise reasonable judgment, situational awareness, and personal responsibility at all times. Guests must follow all posted guidance and staff direction and avoid entering or interfering with any area or activity that presents an obvious hazard.

Failure to adhere to basic safety practices or to follow staff direction may result in removal from the Event without refund.

11. PARKING & PERSONAL PROPERTY

11.1 Parking

Parking is self-managed.

11.2 Vehicle Responsibility

Venue is not responsible for vehicle damage, theft, or contents.

11.3 Vehicle Removal

Vehicles must be removed after the Event or may be towed at owner's expense.

11.4 Personal Property

Venue is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property.

11.5 Lost & Found

Venue may, but is not obligated to, retain found items. Venue assumes no responsibility for lost or unclaimed property.

12. ASSUMPTION OF RISK

12.1 Nature of Venue

Discovery Fire is a working historic farm environment with inherent risks not found in traditional commercial venues.

12.2 Inherent Hazards

Such risks include, but are not limited to, uneven terrain, holes, unstable ground, gravel roads, slippery surfaces, low lighting conditions, non-standard structures, insects including bees, hornets, wasps, and yellow jackets, wildlife and environmental exposure, domestic animals, animal waste, dust, and other agricultural conditions.

12.3 Voluntary Assumption

Guest voluntarily assumes all risks, including injury, illness, allergic reaction, or property damage.

12.4 Allergy Preparedness

Guests with insect sting allergies are responsible for carrying appropriate emergency medication.

12.5 Open and Obvious Conditions

These risks are open and obvious conditions inherent to a rural environment.

12.6 Fire, Heat, Equipment & Cooking Environment Hazards

Guest acknowledges that the Event involves live-fire cooking, open flames, and the use of both small and large-scale cooking, mechanical, and industrial equipment in an active working environment.

Hazards include, but are not limited to:

1. Open flames, fire pits, grills, smokers, and cooking vessels
2. Hot metal surfaces, cast iron, and heated cooking equipment
3. Sparks, embers, ash, and airborne particulates
4. Smoke, heat, and rapidly changing temperature conditions
5. Large and small mechanical or industrial cooking equipment and tools
6. Sharp implements, utensils, and active food preparation areas

Guest understands that these conditions present a significant risk of burns, injury, or property damage.

Guest agrees to maintain a safe distance from all fire, cooking, and equipment areas, comply with all staff instructions, and exercise heightened awareness and caution at all times.

Guests are specifically responsible for supervising minors and ensuring they remain clear of all hazardous areas, equipment, and active cooking zones.

Failure to observe these risks or follow safety direction may result in immediate removal from the Event without refund.

13. RELEASE & LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

13.1 Release

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Discovery Fire is not liable for injuries, damages, or losses arising from attendance, except in cases of gross negligence or willful misconduct.

13.2 Liability Cap

Total liability shall not exceed the ticket price paid.

13.3 Exclusion of Damages

Venue is not liable for indirect, incidental, or consequential damages.

14. EVENT CANCELLATION / FORCE MAJEURE

14.1 Force Majeure Events

Venue is not liable for failure to perform due to events beyond its control, including weather, government action, utility disruption, labor disputes, or similar causes.

14.2 Remedies

Venue may, at its discretion, reschedule the Event, issue partial refunds of up to fifty percent (50%), or provide event credit.

14.3 Convenience Cancellation

If Venue cancels for reasons within its control, a full refund will be issued.

15. PHOTOGRAPHY & MEDIA RELEASE

15.1 Consent

By attending, Guest grants Venue permission to capture and use their image, likeness, and voice.

15.2 Use

Such media may be used for promotional and commercial purposes without compensation.

16. MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

16.1 Authorization

Guest authorizes Venue to obtain emergency medical assistance if necessary.

16.2 Financial Responsibility

Guest is responsible for all associated medical costs.

17. GOVERNING LAW

17.1 Jurisdiction

These Terms & Conditions are governed by the laws of the State of Idaho.

17.2 Venue for Disputes

All disputes shall be resolved in the appropriate courts within the Venue's jurisdiction.

18. SEVERABILITY

18.1 Validity

If any provision is found invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions remain in full force and effect.

19. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

19.1 Complete Agreement

These Terms & Conditions constitute the entire agreement between Discovery Fire and Guest regarding ticketed attendance at the Event.

20. ACCESSIBILITY

20.1 Limited Accessibility

Due to the natural terrain and rural setting, portions of the Venue may be difficult to access for individuals with mobility limitations.

20.2 Surface Conditions

Surfaces include gravel, uneven ground, and natural pathways which may not be suitable for all assistive devices.

20.3 Guest Responsibility

Guests requiring assistance are responsible for arranging appropriate support.

21. EVENT EXCLUSIONS

Unless expressly stated, the Event does not include:

1. Distilled spirits
2. Full-service plated meals
3. Climate-controlled environments
4. Additional tenting or shelter
5. Transportation or mobility services
