



Private Festival Enclave Reservation Terms & Conditions

Companion Addendum to Discovery Fire Event Terms & Conditions

Important:

These Private Festival Enclave Reservation Terms & Conditions apply in addition to the general Discovery Fire Event Terms & Conditions. By purchasing a Private Festival Enclave reservation, the purchaser agrees to these Terms & Conditions and to the general Discovery Fire Event Terms & Conditions on behalf of purchaser and purchaser's group.

1. Scope and Relationship to General Event Terms

1.1 Companion Terms

These Private Festival Enclave Reservation Terms & Conditions govern the reservation, use, and operation of a Private Festival Enclave within DF Live Fire Festival.

1.2 Incorporation of General Event Terms

All general Discovery Fire Event Terms & Conditions remain fully applicable to purchaser and all guests attending the event, including without limitation terms relating to tickets, admission, weather, food and allergens, alcohol, guest conduct, safety, assumption of risk, liability, cancellation, media release, and venue conditions.

1.3 Priority

If there is any conflict between these Private Festival Enclave Reservation Terms & Conditions and the general Discovery Fire Event Terms & Conditions, these Private Festival Enclave Reservation Terms & Conditions control with respect to enclave reservation and enclave-specific matters only.

2. Included Features and Feature-Specific Parameters

Subject to availability, operational fit, event conditions, weather, and Discovery Fire approval, the Private Festival Enclave may include the following features, each subject to the related conditions below.

2.0 Included Features at a Glance

1. Choice of available enclave event space or area
2. Event-grade tables and chairs
3. Floor-length linens
4. Centerpiece elements from available venue inventory
5. Dedicated refuse containers
6. Periodic busing and basic area maintenance
7. Small PA system for low-volume private group remarks
8. Site signage identifying the area as a private event space
9. Opportunity for purchaser-provided branding elements
10. Opportunity to discuss custom requests, upgrades, and enhancements

2.1 Event Space Selection

Feature Summary: *Choice of available enclave event space or area.*

2.1.1 Availability

Spaces are assigned as available based on group size, intended use, operational fit, and festival availability.

2.1.2 Effect on Other Features

Choice of enclave space or area may affect layout, guest flow, visibility, sound conditions, branding opportunities, and other included or requested features.

2.1.3 Final Placement

Final enclave placement remains subject to Discovery Fire operational and safety discretion.

2.2 Tables and Chairs

Feature Summary: *Event-grade tables and chairs for the enclave area.*

2.2.1 Included Furniture

Event-grade tables and chairs will be provided for the enclave area.

2.2.2 Layout Parameters

Furniture layout may vary based on assigned enclave space, guest count, operational needs, and event fit.

2.3 Linens

Feature Summary: *Floor-length linens with color selections from available options.*

2.3.1 Availability

Linen colors and styles are subject to available inventory.

2.3.2 Approval and Fit

Final linen selections remain subject to Discovery Fire approval and operational fit.

2.4 Centerpiece Elements

Feature Summary: *Centerpiece elements from available venue inventory.*

2.4.1 Inventory Limitation

Centerpiece elements are limited to available venue inventory.

2.4.2 Selection and Suitability

Final centerpiece selection is subject to availability, suitability for the assigned enclave space, and Discovery Fire approval.

2.5 Refuse Containers

Feature Summary: *Dedicated refuse containers for the enclave area.*

2.5.1 Included Support

Dedicated refuse containers may be placed within or adjacent to the enclave area as determined by Discovery Fire.

2.5.2 Placement

Container quantity and placement remain subject to layout, guest count, and operational fit.

2.6 Busing and Area Maintenance

Feature Summary: *Periodic busing and basic area maintenance.*

2.6.1 Service Scope

Periodic busing and basic area maintenance are provided for cleanliness and reset support.

2.6.2 Service Limitation

Such support does not include dedicated table-side food or beverage service.

2.7 PA System and Group Address

Feature Summary: *Small PA system for low-volume private remarks, speeches, acknowledgements, and announcements.*

2.7.1 Sound Limitation

Sound levels must remain low and controlled so as not to bleed into the main event area, interfere with main festival music, or materially affect the broader guest experience.

2.7.2 Operational Approval

All PA use remains subject to Discovery Fire approval and operational control.

2.8 Site Signage

Feature Summary: *Site signage identifying the area as a private event space.*

2.8.1 Signage Scope

Signage type, wording, and placement remain subject to Discovery Fire approval and site suitability.

2.9 Purchaser-Provided Branding

Feature Summary: *Opportunity for purchaser-provided branding elements such as balloons, flags, banners, and related display items.*

2.9.1 Purchaser Responsibility

Branding and display items are purchaser-provided unless Discovery Fire expressly agrees otherwise in writing.

2.9.2 Restrictions

Branding items must not obstruct guest flow, emergency access, sightlines, entertainment areas, cooking stations, or festival operations.

2.9.3 Approval Requirement

All branding or display items remain subject to approval and site limitations.

2.10 Custom Requests and Enhancements

Feature Summary: *Opportunity to discuss custom requests, upgrades, enhancements, and special setup needs in advance.*

2.10.1 Approval and Feasibility

All customizations and special requests are subject to advance review, logistical feasibility, staffing, inventory, timing, weather, safety requirements, and Discovery Fire approval.

2.10.2 Additional Cost

Non-standard enhancements may require additional payment.

2.10.3 Non-Refundable Custom Items

Certain approved or ordered custom items may become non-refundable once incurred.

3. Private Festival Enclave Reservation Structure

3.1 Separate Reservation Product

The Private Festival Enclave is a separate reservation product and is not the same as general event admission.

3.2 Reservation Required

A Private Festival Enclave reservation must be purchased in order to reserve private event space within DF Live Fire Festival.

3.3 Purchase Sequence and Guest Tickets

The Private Festival Enclave reservation must be completed first in order to hold or secure private enclave space. Guest admission tickets are separate from the Private Festival Enclave reservation unless Discovery Fire expressly states otherwise in writing. Anticipated guest attendance, guest-ticket planning, or informal group coordination does not reserve enclave space.

3.4 Booking Confirmation

An enclave reservation is not secured until payment is completed and confirmation is issued by Discovery Fire or its authorized ticketing platform.

4. Pricing, Inclusions, and Exclusions

4.1 Enclave Reservation Fee

The Private Festival Enclave reservation fee reserves enclave space and related setup, coordination, and operational allocation for the purchaser's group.

4.2 Admission Not Included Unless Stated

Unless expressly stated otherwise in writing, the enclave reservation fee does not include guest admission tickets, alcoholic beverages, specialty upgrades, merchandise, custom enhancements, or other add-ons.

4.3 Additional Charges

Custom decor, upgraded sound, premium branding elements, specialty installations, special rentals, expanded staffing, or other non-standard enhancements may involve additional cost.

5. Purchaser Responsibilities

5.1 Guest Ticket Responsibility

Purchaser is solely responsible for ensuring that all intended enclave guests obtain valid event admission tickets, unless those tickets are expressly included by Discovery Fire in writing.

5.2 Guest Communication

Purchaser is responsible for communicating applicable event rules, venue conditions, guest conduct requirements, and allergen disclosures to all invited guests.

5.3 Group Conduct and Supervision

Purchaser is responsible for the conduct of purchaser's group within the enclave area and for ensuring that minors are properly supervised.

5.4 Compliance with Event Rules

All enclave guests remain subject to all Discovery Fire event policies, venue rules, alcohol rules, safety rules, and staff direction.

6. Attendance, Guest Count, and Attrition

6.1 No Minimum Attendance Guarantee

The enclave reservation is a space reservation and operational commitment, not a per-person attendance guarantee.

6.2 No Refund Based on Guest Count

No refunds, credits, or price reductions will be issued based on guest attrition, reduced turnout, no-shows, or failure of invited guests to purchase tickets.

6.3 Zero-Turnout Rule

The enclave reservation fee remains fully earned and non-refundable even if actual turnout falls below expectations or drops to zero.

7. Cancellation, Rescheduling, and Refund Policy

7.1 Final Sale

All Private Festival Enclave reservations are final and non-refundable once booked, except as expressly stated in these Terms & Conditions or in the general Discovery Fire Event Terms & Conditions.

7.2 No Client-Side Refunds

No refunds, credits, or exchanges will be issued for client cancellation, guest attrition, reduced attendance, no-shows, scheduling conflicts, travel issues, illness within the group, or any other purchaser-side or guest-side change of plans.

7.3 No Rescheduling

Private Festival Enclave reservations are not eligible for rescheduling. A different date requires cancellation of the original reservation and a new booking, subject to availability, current pricing, and then-current terms. Cancellation of the original reservation does not create any refund right, transfer right, or credit.

7.4 Weather and Event-Level Cancellation

Refunds for the enclave reservation will be considered only in the event of significant inclement weather or event-level cancellation circumstances that, in Discovery Fire's sole reasonable judgment, make the event unsafe or materially impracticable to operate. Nothing in this section limits any remedy expressly required under the general Discovery Fire Event Terms & Conditions if Discovery Fire cancels the event for reasons within its control.

7.5 Ordinary Weather Not Sufficient

Ordinary rain, cool temperatures, heat, smoke haze not rising to a safety closure, muddy conditions, or other generally unfavorable weather conditions do not automatically qualify for refund.

7.6 Scope of Refund Remedy

If Discovery Fire determines that a refund is appropriate under Section 7.4, the refund remedy shall be limited to monies actually paid for the enclave reservation itself, less any approved non-recoverable special-order costs, custom expenses, or third-party charges incurred specifically for purchaser's reservation, if applicable.

8. Discovery Fire Operational Control

8.1 Right to Modify

Discovery Fire reserves the right to modify enclave placement, layout, access paths, setup details, or included elements as reasonably necessary for safety, weather, staffing, entertainment flow, guest movement, or overall event operations.

8.2 No Refund for Operational Adjustments

Reasonable operational adjustments to enclave placement, layout, timing, or included non-material elements do not constitute grounds for refund.

8.3 Venue Control

Discovery Fire retains sole control over event operations, venue management, timing, entertainment coordination, guest flow, and safety requirements.

9. Decor, Installations, and Client Property

9.1 Approval Required

No purchaser decor, displays, installations, signage, branding items, or other materials may be placed on site without prior approval from Discovery Fire.

9.2 Prohibited Items

Open flame decor, fireworks, hazardous materials, confetti, glitter, or any item that creates safety, cleanup, or operational concerns may be prohibited in Discovery Fire's sole discretion.

9.3 Purchaser Property

All purchaser-provided decor, branding items, displays, and related materials are brought to the event at purchaser's own risk. Discovery Fire is not responsible for loss of, theft of, or damage to purchaser-provided property.

9.4 Damage Responsibility

Purchaser is responsible for damage caused by purchaser's guests, agents, vendors, or approved purchaser-installed items.

9.5 Removal of Items

All purchaser-provided items must be removed as directed by Discovery Fire unless otherwise approved in writing. Discovery Fire may remove or discard unapproved, unsafe, or abandoned items at purchaser's expense.

10. No Assignment or Transfer

10.1 No Transfer

The enclave reservation may not be assigned, transferred, sold, sublet, or otherwise conveyed to another party without prior written approval from Discovery Fire.

11. Remedies and Liability

11.1 General Event Liability Terms Apply

All release, limitation-of-liability, and assumption-of-risk provisions contained in the general Discovery Fire Event Terms & Conditions apply fully to the enclave reservation and to all enclave guests.

11.2 No Enlargement of Liability

Nothing in these enclave terms enlarges Discovery Fire's liability beyond what is stated in the general event terms.

12. Entire Agreement and Checkout Acknowledgment

12.1 Entire Enclave Agreement

These Private Festival Enclave Reservation Terms & Conditions, together with the general Discovery Fire Event Terms & Conditions and any written booking confirmation issued by Discovery Fire, constitute the full agreement governing the enclave reservation.

12.2 Checkout Acknowledgment

By proceeding to payment, purchaser confirms that purchaser has reviewed and accepted these Private Festival Enclave Reservation Terms & Conditions and the general Discovery Fire Event Terms & Conditions on behalf of purchaser and purchaser's group.
